Individual “soft” contest

- Starts today at 10.00

- Individual
- Same “rules” as for live contests, use only a team manual and programming language manuals
- Reflect on own experience afterwards in an individual report (see course website for required contents)

Practicalities

- Problem set on paper and in DOMjudge per problem
- Sample input and output available via DOMjudge
- Half of the grade through reflection report
- At most half of the grade through CORRECT problems (0.9 grade points per problem solved; there are more than 5 problems)
- DOMjudge gives penalty for WRONG ANSWER; not the case for course; nor is time until solution take into account
