Purpose of this research study: In this study, we aim at creating a list of central, context-related arguments, based on input provided by participants to a survey.

What you will do in the study: You will annotate arguments based on written input provided by participants to a survey. Additional details are available in the annotation instructions.

Time required: It is dependent on you, as will be explained in the following instructions. Estimated time is maximum 1 hours of uninterrupted annotation. The annotation will take place online.

Risks: There are no risks anticipated in this study. However, in case of doubts or concerns, do not hesitate to contact the researchers.

Privacy and confidentiality: Should you agree to take part, your participation will be completely confidential. All information gathered in the survey will be stored securely in compliance with the standards set by the European Union General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). No one outside the research group will have access to the data during the research period. Background data will be kept by the research group until the analyses are finalized, at the latest in September 2022. No personal information is gathered by our platform. Upon analysis and publication, aggregated information will be made available on open access for other researchers to analyse.

Right to withdraw from the study: Participation in the study is completely voluntary. If at any time you do not wish to continue your participation, you are welcome to withdraw from the survey without penalty.

How to withdraw from the study: You can end your participation by closing the browser window. If you want to withdraw your participation after completing a session, please contact AUTHOR <EMAIL>.
